



PDO. Sussex

- Approved June 2022.
- Still and MT. Sparkling wines grown in the county of Sussex.
 - MT Sparkling from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Meunier Noir.
 - In addition Arbanne, Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc, Petit Meslier & Pinot Noir Précoce
 - Minimum 11% ABV. 85% grapes from vintage if stated
 - Single variety wines minimum 90%
 - Each Cuvée to be approved by Wine Standards.
 - Still: from Acolon, Auxerrois, Bacchus, Chardonnay, Dornfelder, Huxelrebe, Muller Thurgau, Orion, Ortega, Pinot, Blanc, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir, Pinot Noir Précoce, Meunier Noir, Regent, Regner, Reichensteiner, Riesling, Rondo, Roter Veltliner, Schonburger, Siegerrebe, & Solaris

All UK Table Wine and Sparkling wines have to go through a testing and tasting procedure before they can be so labelled.

- Approximately 416 vineyards with a total of 3500ha under vine (780ha. in production 2008)
- Wide range of soils, but Limestone / Chalk predominate in South east. (Kent / Sussex)
- Increasingly recognised for sparkling wine production with traditional varietals
- Sparkling wines now account for 69% of all UK plantings.
- Nyetimber -Sussex and Chapel Down Kent (largest producers)
