

Casauria DOCG

The Casauria DOCG was formerly a sub-zone of the Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC.

The third DOCG of Abruzzo. The area of the Casauria DOCG is situated in the foothills of the Apennines inland from the coastal town of Pescara. Vineyards are located at elevations up to 600 metres.

The DOCG is approved for dry red wines only.

Grape variety: 100% Montepulciano

Minimum alcohol: 13%; 13.5% for Riserva

Ageing: Aged for a minimum of 18 months.

Riserva must be aged for a minimum of 24 months, (from November 1st of the harvest year).

Production, ageing, and bottling must occur within the designated production zone.
