AOP Sable de Camargue

AOP Sable de Camargue. (Previously an IGP region) known for producing Gris style wines. This area has sandy soils, high winds, humidity, and proximity to saltwater marshes. Vineyards are planted on sandy coastal soils between Arles & Agdes (120km)

The Sable de Camargue AOP is approved for rosé wines only; (Vin Gris & Vin Gris de Gris.) Both styles are required to be made using minimal or no skin contact.

The Gris de Gris wines are lighter in colour.

Permitted grape varieties:

□ Sable de Camargue Gris:

- Minimum 55% (combined) Grenache Noir, Grenache Gris, Carignan, Cinsault,
 Grenache Blanc, Marselan, Muscat of Alexandria, Syrah, Ugni Balance and/or Rolle
 (Vermentino)
 - In practice, Grenache Noir and/or Grenache Gris form the majority of most blends.
- Other permitted grapes include Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc

□ Sable de Camargue Gris de Gris:

100% Grenache Gris
