The Yucaipa Valley AVA is situated in San Bernardino County, California and covers a total of 14700 ha.

The valley is located in the foothills of the San Bernardino Mountains, from 600 to 1400 metres above sea level. The high elevation means that it produces thick-skinned grapes with marked tannins and depth of colour.

The inland location has a warm, dry climate. Rainfall is low during the growing season.

Grapes: The principal grape varieties are: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Zinfandel, Syrah, Malbec, Nebbiolo, Barbera, Petite Syrah, and Chardonnay
