

Crystal Springs of Napa Valley AVA

The new AVA is located in Napa County within the North Coast and Napa Valley AVAs.

Location: The Crystal Springs of Napa Valley AVA is located on the western edge of the Vaca Range. Hillside vineyards with no flat areas.

The northern edge abuts the Howell Mountain and Calistoga AVAs

The area's southern boundary is shared with the St. Helena AVA.

Most of the land is below the existing Howell Mountain AVA which requires a minimum height of 427 metres (1400 ft) Howell Mountain AVA sits above the fog line whilst Crystal Springs is largely affected by the maritime fogs

Soil: This part of the Vaca Range consists mainly of volcanic bedrock.

Topsoil, is made up of igneous rock but also includes compacted volcanic ash.

The AVA covers a total of approximately 1620 hectares, with 93 hectares currently planted.

Grape Varieties

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, and Sauvignon Blanc.
