VODKA

- Produced from grain or Molasses spirit which is rectified and passed through activated charcoal to remove flavour.
- Flavourings are often added:
 - Lemon
 - Orange
 - Chilli peppers
 - Herbs
 - Buffalo grass (Zubarowka)

EASTERN EUROPEAN VODKAS

- Produced in Russia, Poland and Balkan countries.
- Retain more character of base material but alcohol may be harsher.
- Potato-based spirits have a creamy luxurious texture.
- Rye-based spirits have a subtle spicy flavour.
- Barley and wheat are also used in production.

WESTERN STYLE VODKAS

- Neutral spirits often with the majority of flavours filtered out
- Innocuous spirits are ideal for mixing.
- Flavoured Vodka:
- Flavourings added such as Orange, Cranberry, Vanilla.
- Some Vodkas follow traditional recipes:
 - Cherries
 - Bison grass
 - Plums
 - Honey
